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
Review all instructions information carefully before installation.



Rear Filler Kit - Component Identification




The Rear Filler Assembly is supplied with two (2) different bottom support plates, clearly labeled SB and LB - Ensure that the correct plate is fitted to this assembly, for your specific installation, before progressing.


Rear Filler Kit - Assembly

Fit the lower door frame, supplied with the Canopy Camper base unit, into the Rear Filler assembly, and tighten the factory fitted fasteners, as below:




Rear Filler Kit - Installation

Remove the tailgate, and fit the Rear Filler Assembly (with the Lower Door Frame fitted):



Canopy Camper Base Unit - Installation & Assembly

Seating the Base Unit




Attach the gasket material to the lower seating surface of the Canopy Camper's base frame - Refer to the stand alone Fitment Instruction for this process.


Lower the Canopy Camper Base Unit onto the already mounted Rear Filler Assembly, as shown in the image above, and align the lower and upper portions of the door frame.

Base Unit to Rear Filler Assembly Connection

Using the supplied hardware, fasten the lower and upper door frames together, on each side of the **EXTERNAL** door opening. See images below:




Using the supplied hardware, fasten the lower and upper door frames together, on each side of the **INTERNAL** door opening. See images below:




Rear Door Rebate Installation

Insert the Rear Door Rebate Frame into the door frame opening, ensure that mounting holes all align. Using the supplied hardware, rivet the frame in place along the LHS, RHS and upper and lower mounting interfaces. See images below:



Rear Door Installation


The Rear Door Assembly is supplied fully assembled with its hinges, and the locking mechanism, as shown below:




Insert the assembled door into the rear door opening. Fasten the four (4) hinges into the nut slot on the RHS door frame first, using the supplied hardware.

Align the two (2) locking mechanism Hook Brackets with the upper and lower lock tabs and fasten into the nut slot on the LHS frame, using the supplied hardware.

Installed Rear Door shown below (rear Filler Assembly removed for clarity):









Mounting Bracket Kit - Installation

Front Mounting Brackets

Remove the tie-down hooks at the front of the load bin (both LH and RH side), and fit the Front Mounting Brackets:










Rear Mounting Brackets


Remove the tie-down hooks at the rear of the load bin (both LH and RH side), and fit the Rear Mounting Brackets:



Centre Mounting Brackets


The centre mounting brackets will only be used on the Long Bed installation, if needed. The main purpose of these brackets is to correct seating along the longer load bin length on the Long Bed installation.

If the Canopy Camper seats and seals correctly, they can be left off. If the camper needs to be pulled downwards towards the load bin wall, these brackets can be installed at centre span between the front and rear mounting brackets, on either side:




NB! The Canopy Camper must rest solely on the mounting brackets and no load is allowed on the load bin. Once this is completed, the Canopy Camper has been installed successfully.

Front Filler Kit - Installation



The long lip of the Front Filler Plate mounts up against the front wall of the load bin. A generous amount of sealant should be applied in an unbroken line, encircling the holes, on the interface surface. The plate will be drilled and riveted to the load bin, in position.

The shorter 90 degree lip will be fastened to the Canopy Camper base unit frame. The Short Bed and Long Bed installations are slightly different.

Short Bed Installation:

Use the supplied M8 fasteners to mount the plate to the base unit frame. Ensure an unbroken line of sealant is applied to the interface surface.

Long Bed Installation:

Use the six (6) small holes in the plate as a drilling template. Drill into the base unit frame of the Canopy Camper. Ensure an unbroken line of sealant is applied to the interface surface, before riveting the plate in position.
